## What's happening?

First, the spire will have all the shingles replaced. — These recently suffered from the storms and need to be made safe by replacing with new.The new cedar shingles will weather to grey in a few months.

Next, the South faces of the Chancel and the Main and South Aisles will have the old tiles removed and replaced with new tiles with a similar dark appearance. The roof structure will be made more water-proof.

The work will commence in July and is expected to complete by December, subject to weather conditions.

The project has been financed by Highfield Church congregation.
