Growing in GRACE

Over the next quarter, our sermon themes are drawn from our statement of Values and Vocations. We're going to be preaching about who we are (or should be) as a church, and about what we feel called to be and to do in the place where God has planted us.

We'll spend two or three weeks on each of our five values, which make up the acrostic GRACE: Grace-filled Community, Reverent Worship, Authentic Discipleship, Christ-like Service and Empowered Witness. We'll also spend one Sunday on each of three Vocations: Engaging with the University, Embracing Portswood and Loving Southampton.

As these Values and Vocations are intended to embrace and be embraced by all of our three main congregations, the sermon themes for the next four months will normally be the same across the whole day.

We'll end the series on June 7th with a challenge to devote ourselves to these Values and Vocations and to the challenge for us all to be growing in GRACE.
